

Remember, but Don't Look Back

"Always **remember** that you were slaves in Egypt and that the Lord your God redeemed you from your slavery." Deuteronomy 24:18

"...**Remember**, he has identified you as his own, guaranteeing that you will be saved on the day of redemption." *Ephesians 4:30*

But Jesus told him, "Anyone who puts a hand to the plow and then **looks back** is not fit for the Kingdom of God." *Luke 9:62*

BIG IDEA:

Remembering our past builds faith and endurance in us as we recall God's faithfulness, but the past is not meant to be a source of comfort or refuge: God is.

The Benefits of Remembering

- 1. Roots us in God's Story
- 2. Affirms us our call in Christ
- 3. *Protects us* during times of testing and trials.
